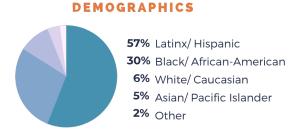


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#### Who We Are

#### **Out-of-School Program**

Our Out-of-School program, *Running Mates*, utilizes running and physical activity to improve social and emotional well-being of young people in 3rd through 12th grade. This program helps young people develop a positive self-image, learn goal setting, and build relationships with peers and positive mentors.
